OLIVE WOOD BRIQUETTES

Ember Olive Wood Briquettes are sourced from endlessly renewable and sustainable olive groves of Tunisia. With over 1.82 million hectares of olive groves, this regions tree pruning plays an important role in renewing the fruiting surface of the tree to achieve higher fruit yields and maintain vegetative growth of fruiting shoots.

The resulting Olive wood biomass is dried, ground and sieved to form a sawdust. This sawdust is transferred to a high-pressure briquetting machine to obtain natural logs, without the use of any glues or wax.

BENEFITS OF OLIVE WOOD BRIQUETTES INCLUDE:

- Easy to light
- Long burn time
- Provides consistent glow & warmth
- No additives; glues or waxes

HOW TO USE:

1. Remove Briquettes from plastic shrink wrapping
2. Place some Ember kindling and 3 or 4 Ember firelighters onto the fire grate, and light to establish a fire.
3. Once fire is burning freely, break up an Ember Olive Briquette into 3 or 4 pieces, and place on top of fire to establish flame and heat.
4. Once the fire has taken to the olive wood, add additional briquettes to maintain, ensuring good airflow; for a warm, smoke free fire.
5. Add another Ember Olive Wood Briquette once embers have died down, to prolong the fire.

FAQ'S

Q - Why use this product over firewood?

A - Briquettes provide easy handling, can be stored inside, do not contain any dirt, dust or bugs. They are perfectly sized for clean and easy handling.

Q - What is the best method of lighting briquettes?

A - We recommend using a handful of kindling, along with 3 to 4 firelighters to establish a fire with enough heat to maintain prolonged burn of the briquettes.

Q - How many to put into the fire (recommended number)

A - Start with 1 to 2 briquettes, and increase depending on length and heat required from fire.

Q - Is there particular positioning that may work better?

A- We recommend stacking the briquettes to allow for ventilation. This will provide a cleaner burn.

Q - What happens if my briquettes do not burn properly.

A - We recommend that you break up the briquettes into smaller pieces, to increase airflow. This should allow the fire to take hold readily.

Q - Are briquettes easy to break up.

A - Yes, briquettes will easily break into 3 or 4 pieces when gently pried apart.

Q - When should you add another log to the fire?

A - We recommend adding another log once the initial log(s) have burnt down and still glowing. Remember that each additional log will prolong the fire for up to 2-hours.

Q - How long do they burn for?

A - Up to 2 hours.

Q - Do they leave a lot of ash behind?

A - Some ash remains, but most is burnt up in the fire.

Q - Do they flame up?

A - The briquettes establish some flame, but once alight, provide a consistent glow and warmth.

Q - Do they crackle like firewood?

A - No, they do not.

Q - Do they expand or change shape as they burn?

A - Briquettes will slowly break apart whilst burning.

Q - Do they spark or spit at all?

A - No, briquettes provide a consistent burn without sparking or spitting like a traditional fire. We still recommend the use of fire grills and grates when used in-home.

Q - Is there any smell associated with burning them?

A - Briquettes do not expel any offensive smell when burning.
